EMS personnel respond to over ½ million calls annually for accidents as diverse as heart attacks, automobile accidents, drownings, childbirth, gunshot wounds and many more. Grand River Technical School offers 4 levels of EMS training

- **First responder**

Usually first on the scene, and trained to perform basic emergency care.

- **EMT/Basic**

Training in care for patients on scene & in transport by ambulance. Skills to assess a patient's condition and manage respiratory, cardiac and trauma emergencies.

- **Paramedic**

Administration of IV fluids and use of manual defibrillators, advanced airway treatment, administering necessary drugs, interpreting EKGs, performing intubations, using complex lifesaving equipment.

Provides the most extensive pre-hospital care.

- **Firefighter I & II**

Expert training to prepare for emergency situations – fighting fires, handling medical emergencies, rescuing and treating the injured, and educating the public.
